### **Itinerary**

**Sunday, April 4<sup>th</sup>**

***Departure times from our area TBD depending on flight times at Philadelphia International Airport.***

#### **Arrive in Honolulu and Transfer to the Hotel**

Upon arrival in Honolulu, you will be met at the baggage claim area with a Traditional Flower Lei Greeting. Next, your motorcoach will transport you to your hotel where you are met by our local escort. The remainder of your day is free to rest from the flight or take a walk on the beach. Dinner is on your own tonight.

**Monday, April 5<sup>th</sup>**

#### **Pearl Harbor, City Sightseeing, & Local Dinner**

*After breakfast, you are met by a private coach and make the trip to Pearl Harbor. The USS Arizona Memorial, along with the other memorials and historical sites that make up Pearl Harbor, supplies an overview of the lead up to World War II and its impact on Hawaii. After spending time at the memorial, you will board a boat that will take you to the stationary platform built over the sunken remains of the USS Arizona, resting place of 1,102 of the 1,177 sailors and Marines that died during the attack (pending availability). You will enjoy an included lunch while in Pearl Harbor.*

*Next visit the National Memorial of the Pacific, also known as Punchbowl Crater, final resting place of those who service in our armed forces. From there take a short drive to downtown Honolulu, capital of Hawaii. It is the site of Iolani Palace, the only royal palace in America, which house Hawaiian rules.*

*After your tour, you return to your hotel for a little bit of free time before dinner. Enjoy the flavors of the Hawaiian culture and after dinner you will have more free time to explore Waikiki or relax at the hotel.*

**Tuesday, April 6<sup>th</sup>**

#### **Oahu Grand Circle Island Tour**

*Today, your tour of the beautiful island of Oahu highlights famous, must-see landmarks and scenic vistas. You will begin with a drive through Oahu's Southern part of the island going toward the beautiful eastern coastline. Make a stop at the Halona Blowhole and then make your way around the island to Nuuanu Pali Lookout. After a stop at the lookout you will head to the Byodo-In Temple for another stop to view the temple grounds. Later today you make your way up the North Eastern Coastline and drive past Mokoli'i and the world famous Sunset and Waimea Bay as you cross the island's big wavy territory. The region is known for its fabulously large wintertime waves and international surfing competitions. End your day traveling through the central valley pineapple fields and make a stop at Dole Plantation to visit their gift shop and everyone can enjoy the world's freshest Hawaiian pineapple. Return to your hotel where your evening is free and dinner is on your own.*

**Wednesday, April 7<sup>th</sup>**

#### **Free Day in Oahu**

*After breakfast at the hotel, you will have the entire day free to relax in Waikiki, go to the beach, go shopping, take surfing lessons, go hiking at the famous Diamond Head Hik – the possibilities are endless. There will be optional tours for you to choose from at an extra fee, if desired. (Helicopter tours, snorkeling, submarine tour, sunset catamaran tours, etc.)*

**Thursday, April 8<sup>th</sup>****Maui – The Valley Isle**

*After breakfast we transfer to the airport for a short flight to beautiful Maui for a three-night stay at the Outrigger Kaanapali Beach Resort. The balance of the day is yours to enjoy.*

**Friday, April 9<sup>th</sup>****Best of Maui – Haleakala – Iao Valley & Country Towns**

*After breakfast, today you will enjoy the Best of Maui tour. Experience Maui's highlights on this laid-back journey showcasing nature's finery, historic landmarks, and charming country towns. Haleakala is truly magnificent in the daytime hours while bathed in sunlight which brings its steep slopes to center stage. See Nene geese in their native habitat and discover the secret of the rare Silversword plant. Enjoy lunch on your own in Makawao town and browse unique shops and galleries. Make a brief stop at Kula Marketplace for one-of-a-kind gift shopping*

**Hawaiian Luau Dinner**

*This evening your farewell dinner is an authentic Hawaiian Luau. A grand celebration of food, entertainment, and Polynesian culture at sunset. Luau tradition begins with a Kalua pig cooked in an imu (earth oven), with Haupia (coconut pudding) and poi (Hawaiian taro starch). Then under the stars you witness a live musical performance of the hula.*

*After breakfast, today you will have the entire day free to relax in beautiful Ka'anapali, Maui. There will be optional tours for you to choose from at an extra fee. (Helicopter tours, snorkeling, sunset catamaran tours, etc.)*
